Hunt-Coffey has spent the last 32 years in local government, serving in a variety of roles at the City of Glendale before being named Director of Libraries there in 2004. She joined the City of Beverly Hills in 2008 as Assistant Director of Community Services and was named Director in 2016.

Hunt-Coffey earned her Bachelor of Arts Degree in English and Spanish Literature from Occidental College and her Master's Degree in Information Studies from UCLA.

The City will name an Interim Director of Community Services in the coming weeks with the formal recruitment for a new Director beginning this spring. The Community Services Director oversees the City's Recreation, Library, Human Services and Administrative Support divisions.
